# Michael M. Belenky May 25, 1933 - April 12, 2014

Dr. Michael Mitchell Belenky, 80, a thirty-three year resi of Arnold, died on Saturday, April 12 at his residence. Bor May 25, 1933 in Detroit, MI to the late Michael W. and Belenky, Michael graduated from the Virginia Military Inst in Lexington, VA in 1955 with a Bachelor of Arts degre biology, from the University of Michigan Dental School in Arbor, MI in 1961 with a Doctor of Dental Surgery degree from the Johns Hopkins University, School of Public Heal Baltimore in 1975 with a Master of Public Health degree served in the U.S. Army as an Artillery Officer from 195 and as a Dental Corps Officer from 1961 until his retireme 1980 as a Colonel. He served with the 173rd Airborne Brid in Vietnam and his numerous assignments also included 82nd Airborne Division, 10th Special Forces Group, U.S. F Forces Command, U.S. Army Medical Research Development Command, and Headquarters, 7th Me Command, United States Army Europe. He was awarded Legion of Merit, Bronze Star, Army Commendation Me Combat Medic Badge and Senior Parachutist Badge. Afte retirement from the military, Michael was an Asso Professor at the University of Maryland Dental Scl Department of Health Promotion and Policy, from 1983-2 He was a Life Fellow of the American College of Dentis Fellow of the International College of Dentists, a Fellow of Pierre Fauchard Academy, a Life member of the Amei Dental Association, the Maryland State Dental Association Baltimore City Dental Society, the American Dental Educa Association, the Omicron Kappa Upsilon National Dental H Society, and the 173rd Airborne Brigade Association. Mic enjoyed military history, reading and international travel is survived by his wife, Mary F. "Mitzi" Belenky, whon married on January 26, 1974; sons, Michael F. (Bly Belenky of Alexandria, VA and Alexis J. Belenky of Arr brother, Dr. Walter M. Belenky of Detroit, MI an grandchildren, Sarah M., Emma F., and Michael C. Belenk of Alexandria, VA.
